Basic Services of Funeral Provider and Staff	\$300.00
<i>This charge includes arrangement conference, planning and coordinating the final disposition, securing required authorization forms and permits, obtaining demographic information for and filing of death certificate, obtaining certified copies of death certificate, coordinating and planning with others as needed, such as clergy, churches, musicians, cemeteries, crematories, newspapers, florists, etc. This fee also includes a proportionate share of our overhead costs such as insurance, local, state, and federal taxes, maintenance, salaries, etc. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charge for direct cremations, direct burial, and forwarding or receiving deceased.)</i>	
Embalming	\$400.00
<i>Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial or when refrigeration or use of dry ice is available.</i>

A cremation container is a combustible closed container resistant to the leakage of bodily fluids that encases the body and can be made of material like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The container we provide is the minimum cardboard container.</i>
